Please let your club members know that the Alamogordo RCers will hold a fun fly event beginning at 9:00AM on 10 October 2020, at our flying field.

The fun fly events on our program are:

- * Thirty-second climb and glide
- * Spot landing
- * Egg drop (materials are provided by us)
- * Roops (three rolls and three loops, touch-and-go, three rolls and three loops, land)

All AMA pilots are invited. Pilots should bring their AMA license card for identification. Turbine-powered aircraft are generally not allowed due to fire danger.

We ask for a \$15 donation from each pilot to help with costs. Due to COVID we will not have on-site food service. There are several fast food and regular restaurants nearby including McDonalds, Sonic, Caliches, etc.
